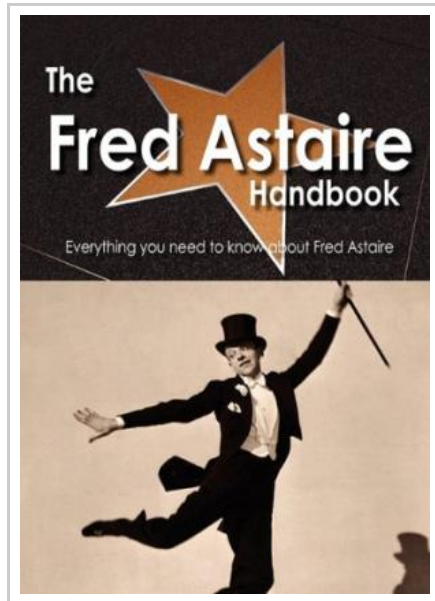




The Fred Astaire Handbook - Everything You Need to Know about Fred Astaire

He is particularly associated with Ginger Rogers, with whom he made ten films. Gene Kelly, another major innovator in filmed dance, said that the history of dance on film begins with Astaire. Beyond film and television, many classical dancers and choreographers, Rudolf Nureyev, Sammy Davis Jr. , Michael Jackson, Gregory Hines, Mikhail Baryshnikov, and Jerome Robbins among them, also acknowledged his importance and influence.
