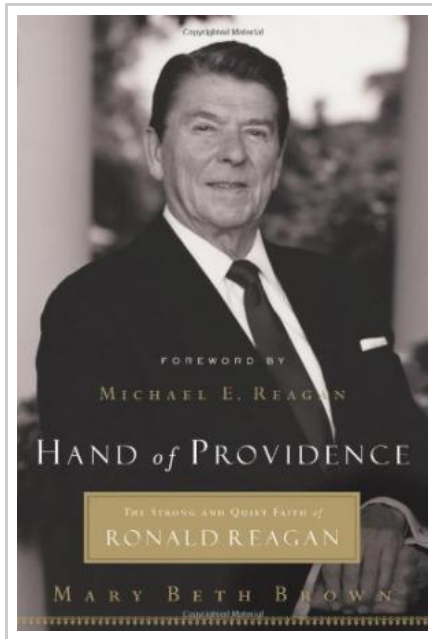




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Hand of Providence: The Strong and Quiet Faith of Ronald Reagan (Paperback)
