Eighty-ve percent of the guests were with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and had been in the hotel for one and a half weeks at the time of there. Of the other 15 percent, many were seasonal guests who had been residing in the hotel for an extended period. Occupant familiarity is thought to have contributed to the large number of guests who were able to evacuate on their own, and probably eased the anxiety of those evacuated by there department in smoky conditions. LESSONS LEARNED The La Posadare demonstrated once again the value of smoke detectors in providing early, life-sav-ing warning ofre. A working detector and the quick response of there department, coupled with their tactical decision to focus stafng on...



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
